## **INFORMATION**

*Each level has **three sessions of 10 weeks.***

***Bouts de Choux and Smart 4** has **1 hour** per week.*

***Smart 5/6, Smart 7/9 and Smart 10/12** has **1 ½ hours** par week.*

*The Smart Steps programs adhere strictly by age.*

*The cut-off date for each year is **OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup>.***

*Exemple : If your child is 5 before October 1<sup>st</sup>, he/she will be in Smart 5 & 6.*

*If he/she is 5 after October 1<sup>st</sup>, he/she will be in Smart 4.*

*If you are unsure of the class your child should be in, please contact our office.*

*In order, to take a Smart Steps 7/9 and Smart 10 to 12 classes,  
you must register for all three sessions.*

*Bouts de Choux, Smart Steps 4 and Smart Steps 5/6 classes can register at any  
session.*

*The “**Livre de l’élève**” and the **Audio CD** are optional, but we recommend  
buying them, so you can use them at home with your you child in order to follow  
up on his/her progress at class..*

*Books can be purchased anytime at the office before the classes starts.*

*We can not accept students and admit them in class unless their name is on the  
list of confirmed students provided to the teachers at the beginning of each  
session by the registration office.*
